## **Changes in the Managing Board of HUGO BOSS AG**

Metzingen. The Supervisory Board of HUGO BOSS AG has today passed a resolution that the new distribution of business responsibilities in the Managing Board as from November 1, 2005 will provide for only four management areas. The reorganization serves for the restructuring of the Group, with a consistent orientation towards brands, markets and customers.

The stepping down from office within the Managing Board by Mr Lothar Reiff, responsible for the area of Creation and Licences, with effect on October 31, 2005, was approved by the Supervisory Board.

In future, the Brand and Creation managers for BOSS will report to Dr. Bruno Sälzer; Mr André Maeder will take over the areas of Licences and HUGO.

The appointment of Mr Jörg-Viggo Müller, responsible for the areas of Finances, Personnel, Administration and IT, will end contractually on March 31, 2006.

On April 1, 2006, Mr Joachim Reinhardt, currently Finance Director at the Gillette Group, Kronberg, will be appointed as a member of the Managing Board, as Mr Müller's successor.

The Supervisory Board and Managing Board of HUGO BOSS AG would like to thank Mr Reiff and Mr Müller for all they have achieved over many years of working for the company.
